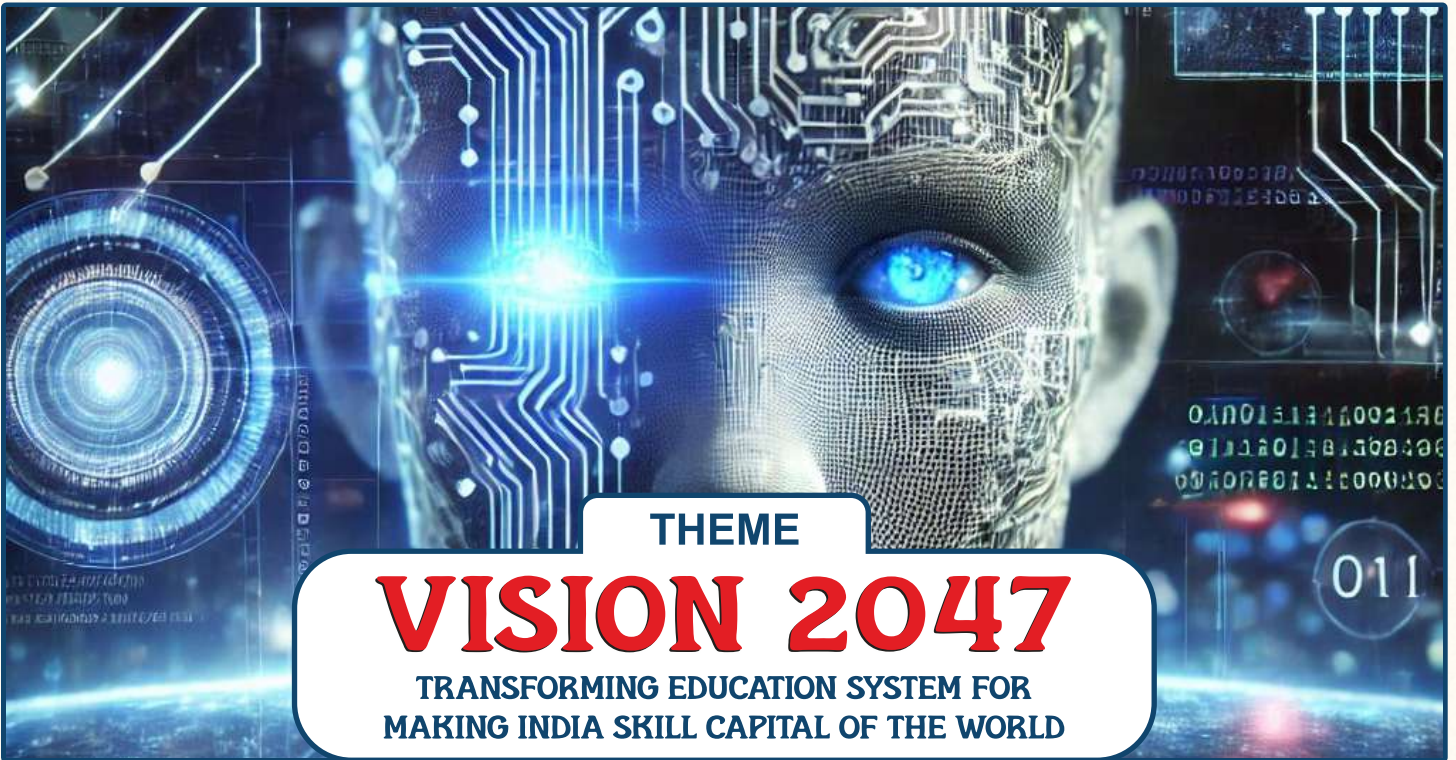
ABOUT ISTE

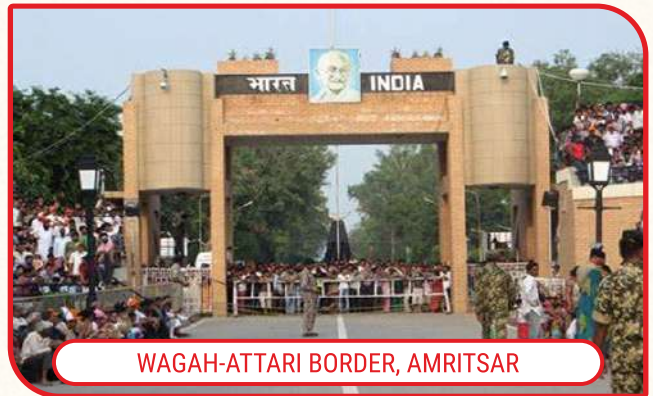

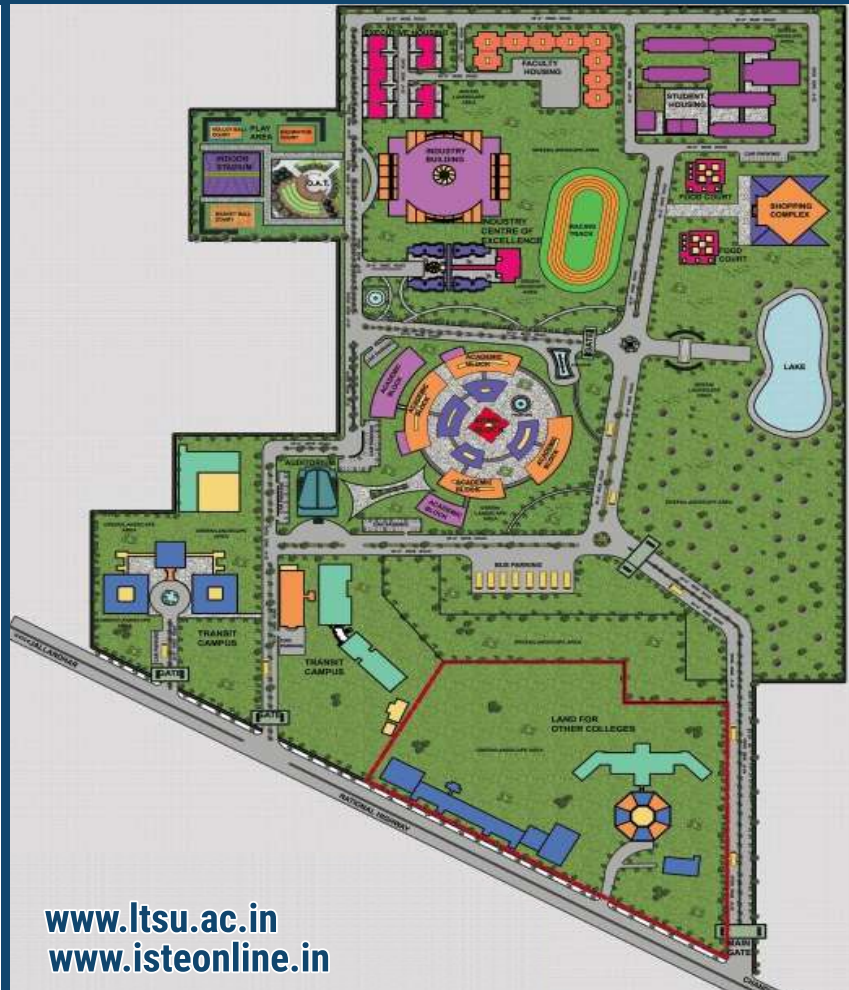
